## Sky Pirates Fee Schedule

Adult Members (19 years old or older at time of joining or renewing)

• Annual dues for Adult Members are \$100 per year.

<u>Junior Members</u> (younger than 19 or full-time students at time of joining or renewing)

• Annual dues for Junior Members are \$50 per year

## <u>Pro-rating of dues part way through the flying season:</u>

- Pro-rating applies to Junior Members and Adult Members.
- Dues will be reduced by 50% for new and former members who join during or after the August meeting.
- New and former members who join for the following year during or after the November meeting may fly for the remainder of the present year at no charge.
- A *former member* is defined as one who has let his membership lapse for at least one full year. Pro-rating is not applicable to a member who is simply late in renewing his membership. Exceptions to this rule will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

## Assessments

- Dues assessments will be charged when Club expenses exceed the Club treasury. Assessments vary from year to year depending upon the number of members and the costs for renting and maintaining the Club's flying site.
- Junior Members will not be charged assessments.
- The assessments for new and former Adult Members who join during or after the August meeting will be reduced by 50%.
- New and former members who join for the following year during or after the November meeting of the present year will not be responsible for any assessment of the present year.
- A former member who rejoins the Club must pay any assessment in arrears from the year he was last a member. Exceptions to this rule will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

<u>Payment Date:</u> The Club asks that renewing members pay their dues no later than the March meeting.

<u>Hardships and Special Situations:</u> The Sky Pirates is dedicated to promotion of the aero-modeling hobby and will consider financial hardships and special situations on a case-by-case basis.

<u>Donations</u>: The Club will graciously accept donations of money and R/C equipment. Donations will be used to cover Club expenses and to promote the aero-modeling hobby through youth programs, flight training and membership recruitment.
